TASTING NOTES

Aromatics of vanilla bean, ripe orchard fruit, and caramel are warm and inviting. On the palate, the Chardonnay is perfectly oaky and buttery and notes of clove, vanilla, Asian pear and banana are balanced by mild minerality and a touch of citrus on the finish. Liquid Gold for sure!

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Adobe Road Chardonnay returned for the 2014 vintage after a five year hiatus and we were happy to source amazing fruit from this well-known Chardonnay vineyard which gained recognition during the 1976 Paris tasting when 40% of the vineyard's fruit was used in making Chateau Montelena's winning wine. Our 2014 Bacigalupi Chardonnay won a number of accolades, including 90 points from Wine Spectator.

THE VINTAGE

The 2014 vintage was known for having the earliest start on record, coming on the heels of the third consecutive drought year in Sonoma County. However, there was just enough rainfall to charge the soil with water, making the growing conditions ideal in the dry winter and warm spring, which yielded a larger than average crop.
