

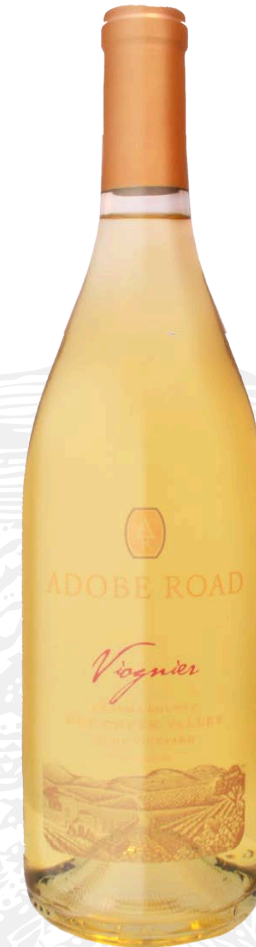

87 Points “The 2014 Viognier Kemp Vineyard from Dry Creek has a nice solid, fleshy mid-core and offers peach and apricot scents. The wine is medium-bodied, with not as much finesse aromatically as I might have expected, but it is a cleanly made, good, fleshy, chunky wine that will certainly complement flavorful poultry and seafood dishes. Drink it over the next year.” -Robert Parker 85 Points “An intense, spicy mix of citrus and pear flavors, with toast and cedar notes taking over, finishing slightly coarse. Drink now. 145 cases made.–MW for The Wine Spectator _PP_A classic Viognier marked by powerful floral aromatics as well as aromas of white peach, lime zest, and wet minerality. The orchard fruit continues through to the palate, where the light and refreshing mouthfeel is comprised of both yellow and white peaches, underripe pear, and undertones of wet concrete balanced by crisp acidity. A wonderful expression of the varietal in the classic sense, especially when compared to the preceding ‘13 vintage. Enjoyed best slightly chilled in its youth.
